


Oklahoma's Access to Insurance

Oklahoma's Health Plans support the State's economy by employing 3,512 health plan employees and 10,159 insurance-related employees, generating a total \$887.2 million in employee income. Additionally, the state has gained \$448.9 million in State Premium Tax collections.
